* Payment for the Wheelchair events may be arranged at the venue on the day of the event. Entry in any other event grants you **free** entry into the Wheelchair events, but online registration for the Wheelchair events is required.

The above times are for **close of registration**. Fencers not present at close of registration will be withdrawn. All times Central Standard (SK time). All events are conditional on a minimum of 3 entries received by the deadline.

FEE: \$35 registration fee + \$40 per event (all events, all age categories) or
\$25 registration fee + \$30 per event for payment received by discount deadline.

Fencers may enter more than one event on each day; however they will be required to withdraw from an event if their entry will impede the progress of the competition. Fencers must remain in the event in progress.

LATE CHECK-IN: \$10 PENALTY (if allowed to fence by Directoire)

ENTRY **AND FEE** MUST BE SUBMITTED **ONLINE** BY: **10:00 pm (CST), Friday, Mar. 9th**

RULES: The latest FIE rules will apply except regarding FIE clothing and FIE blades. **ALL COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROPER FENCING CLOTHING. NO SWEATPANTS OR WINDPANTS WILL BE ALLOWED.**
