Age Restrictions

Under-10 fencers must be born 2009 or since. Under-13 fencers must be born 2006 or since. Cadet fencers must be born 2002 or since. Junior fencers must be born 1999 or since. Veteran fencers must be born 1989 or before.

Fees

There is a \$35 registration fee plus \$40 per event, or a \$25 registration fee plus \$30 per event if registration is completed by the Early Bird Deadline. Fencers competing in the Open and Wheelchair events in a weapon may compete in the Wheelchair event for free and may register for that event when checking in for the Open at the venue on the day of the event.

Online Registration

All entrants except Under-10 fencers must register online at skfencing.ca. Registration for Wheelchair events may be arranged at the venue on the day of the event; If you are registering for Wheelchair events for which you **will not** be fencing in the corresponding Open event, you may register online for the Early Bird Discount.

Rules and Regulations

Fencers may enter more than one event on each day, but they may be required to withdraw from an event if their entry will impede the progress of the competition. Fencers must remain in the event in progress.

The Latest FIE rules will apply except regarding FIE clothing and FIE blades. **All Competitors are required to wear proper fencing clothing. No sweatpants or windpants will be allowed.**

Sanctioned by the Canadian Fencing Federation through the Saskatchewan Branch. All Canadian competitors must be 2017-18 licensees of the CFF. All Saskatchewan competitors must be current SFA Regular Members except Veteran event participants may hold either a current Regular or Limited Membership.
